SPECIAL ACTIVITIES TO LIGHT YOUR CAMPER'S FIRE!!

Swim Lessons: Basic swim skills like floating and beginner strokes are a breeze as campers become comfortable in the water and learn to enjoy it in a safe way through games and many fun activities. Eight 30-minute lessons over the two-week sessions are provided with the Fridays reserved for lesson make-ups due to inclement weather. Taught by our certified lifeguards. *Available all summer!*

Little Picassos Art Lessons - Nature Art: This is a fun art camp designed for the students to explore nature through different art techniques and subject matter. Instructed by our World Academy Visual Arts teacher, Teresa Iannone, your student will complete two to three awesome pieces during this week. This week of 5 one-hour lessons will be the perfect venue for creating perfect natural art pieces!! Space is limited! *Available June 24th-28th.*

Soccer Camp: A variety of fun activities will illustrate the foundational skills of soccer and game playing for our campers. They will learn to develop large muscle skills and the special techniques of soccer while working as a team! Come prepared with active clothes, sneakers or soccer shoes, bug repellent/sunscreen, and water bottle. Kyle Precourt, NH certified Physical Education teacher, will be conducting this one week of 5 one-hour sessions camp. *Available June 17th-21st and August 19th-23rd.*

Basketball Camp: Taught by Kyle Precourt, NH certified Physical Education teacher, this camp will focus on learning the game and basic basketball skills, then further develop those skills and talents and engage campers in team play. Learn the strategy of a winning team member! *Available June 24th-28th and August 12th-16th.*

Project Adventure: If hiking, outdoor team activities, wilderness survival skills, outdoor arts and crafts, and nature experiences are your campers' thing, this is for them!!! The focus of this activity is to help campers develop an appreciation for the natural resources all around them and to help them find the fun to be had in the great outdoors! This activity is offered by Kyle Precourt, NH certified Physical Education teacher, for one and a quarter hour sessions each day. Come prepared with active clothes, sneakers, a water bottle, bug repellent/sunscreen, hat and high energy!! *Available July 1st-5th.*

Little Picassos Art Lessons - Color Splash Art: If your student loves art and color he/she won't want to miss out on this camp! Students will create a variety of art pieces using color theory with paints and other materials. Instructed by our World Academy Visual Arts teacher, Teresa Iannone, your student will complete two projects during this week. One week of 5 one-hour lessons will allow your artist time to create two perfect animal masterpieces!! Space is limited! *Available July 8th-July 12th.*

Volleyball Camp: Taught by Kyle Precourt, NH certified Physical Education teacher, campers will learn the skills of the serve, forehand pass, and set. Campers will practice these skills and incorporate them into game play at the end of the week! Your camper will gain excitement for the sport and confidence in his/her skills in no time. *Available July 8th-12th.*

Floor Hockey Camp: Guided by Kyle Precourt, NH certified Physical Education teacher, your camper will learn the foundations of the game of floor hockey, including how to develop zone and stick skills through games and drills. Your camper will gain excitement for the sport and confidence in his/her skills in no time. *Available July 15th-18th.*

Students will create an animal mask, then take a painting adventure into the jungle using tempera paints. Cricket Camp: Taught by Kyle Precourt, NH certified Physical Education teacher, this camp will focus on learning the basic skills to play the game of cricket including bowler, batting, and fielding. Cricket is one of the most popular sports in the world and by the end of the week campers will be comfortable with rules and basics skills of this international sport. *Available July 22nd-26th.*

Lego Robotics Camp: Master Builder Dan Hughes from the NH Lego League orchestrates incredible opportunities for our campers to build teams and support creativity skills, while participating in design and construction.
