SPECIAL ACTIVITIES TO LIGHT YOUR CAMPER'S FIRE!!

Swim Lessons: Basic swim skills like floating and beginner strokes are a breeze as campers become comfortable in the water and learn to enjoy it in a safe way through games and many fun activities. Eight 30-minute lessons over the two-week sessions are provided with the Fridays reserved for lesson make-ups due to inclement weather. Taught by our certified lifeguards. *Available all summer!*

Little Picassos Art Bugs: A fun art camp designed for the students to explore insects through different art techniques and subject matter. Instructed by our World Academy Visual Arts teacher, your student will complete two to three pieces during this week. One week of 5 one-hour lessons will be the perfect time to create perfect bugsterpieces!! Space is limited; sign up now! *Available June 18th-22nd.*

Soccer Camp: A variety of fun activities will illustrate the foundational skills of soccer and game playing for our campers. They will learn to develop large muscle skills and the special techniques of soccer while working as a team! Come prepared with active clothes, sneakers or soccer shoes, bug repellent/sunscreen, and water bottle. Kyle Precourt will be conducting this one week of 5 one-hour sessions camp. *Available from June 18th-22nd for campers entering Grades 2 & up and June 25th-29th for campers entering Grade 1.*

Project Adventure: If hiking, outdoor team activities, wilderness survival skills, outdoor arts and crafts, and nature experiences are your campers' thing, this is for them!!! The focus of this activity is to help campers develop an appreciation for the natural resources all around them and to help them find the fun to be had in the great outdoors! This activity is offered by Kyle Precourt for one-hour sessions each day. Come prepared with active clothes, sneakers, a water bottle, bug repellent/sunscreen, hat and high energy!! *Available from July 2nd - 6th.*

Dance Camp: Lindsay Lacasse, our prima ballerina Dance Instructor with more than 20 years dance experience and owner of her own dance studio, will teach campers the foundations of movement and music while sharing basic steps and bringing out the creativity of your dancer. Each style is unique and Lindsay will take your child on a magical dance journey of each type!! One week of 5 thirty-minute sessions will have your camper dancing up a storm!! *Available July 23rd-27th. (Ballet and Tap available for campers entering Grade 1 and Hip Hop available for campers entering Grades 2 & up)*

Floor Hockey Camp: With the help of Kyle Precourt as your guide, your camper will learn the foundations of the game of floor hockey including how to develop zone and stick skills through games and drills. Your camper will gain excitement for the sport and confidence in his/her skills in no time. *Available July 30th -August 3rd for campers entering Grades 2 & up and August 6th- 10th for campers entering Grade 1*

Little Picassos Animal Art: If you're student loves animals and art you don't want to miss out on this camp! Students will create a 3D paper-mache animal, then take a painting adventure into the deep sea using watercolors. Instructed by our World Academy Visual Arts teacher, your student will complete two projects during this week.
