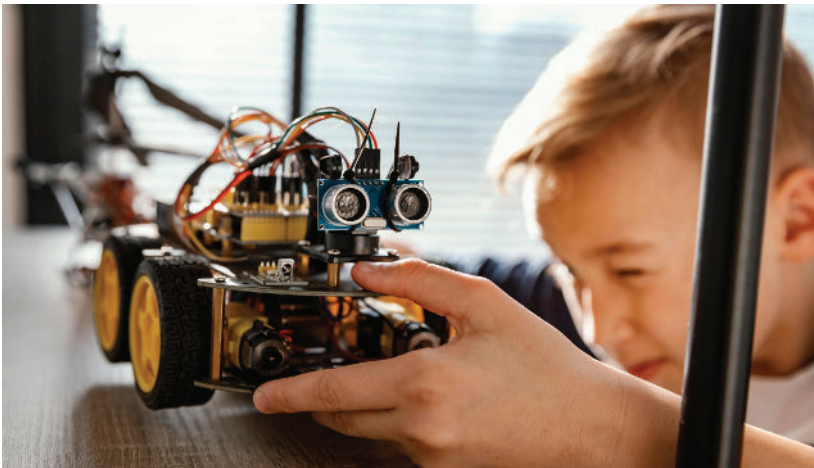

THEMES & ACTIVITIES



JUNE 16TH - 27TH - LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION!

The first two weeks of camp will invite your camper to jump into the worlds created by television, movies, and books. With puzzling mental activities and physical challenges based on Survivor and The Amazing Race, campers will be encouraged to play their way through a tour of the world, all while exploring characters and extraordinary plots to create their very own version of Comic Con.

JUNE 30TH - JULY 11TH - ADVENTURE LAND

These energy-filled weeks are themed around amazing outdoor experiences. The first is based on the popular Discovery Channel event "Shark Week". Campers will dive into the fascinating world of sharks through hands-on activities, games, crafts, and educational lessons about different shark species, their habitats, and the vital role they play in the ocean ecosystem. The second week will focus on spending time outdoors while basking in the sun's rays and celebrating our country through All American fun like football, picnics, and water games during Beach Bash and Party in the USA!

JULY 14TH - 25TH - EARTH WIND AND FIRE!

Science and STEAM are the focus of week one of these engaging weeks. Campers will become explorers of nature and the wild world around them. Scavenger hunts for creatures, crafts and activities focused on the outdoors and animals will be the focus of the first week in Buggin' Out and Blowing off STEAM. In week number two, campers will enter into new worlds that will mystify the senses. Campers will explore the Enchanted Forest while creating new worlds and characters through storytelling, dramatic performances, and magical creations with crafts.

JULY 28TH - AUGUST 8TH - TO THE EXTREME!

These weeks are focused on pushing campers beyond their comfort zones with physically demanding activities like rock wall climbing, hiking, relay races, and other adventurous pursuits. Activities and games will emphasize personal challenge, leadership development, and building resilience. Campers will look for clues, find and examine artifacts, and solve mysteries with mini themes including Mission Impossible, Raiders of the Lost Artifact, and Time Travel Treasure Hunters.

AUGUST 11TH - 22ND - MYSTERY MADNESS

During these weeks, campers will experience activities and games designed around solving intricate mysteries, participate in immersive scenarios filled with puzzles, cryptic clues, secret identities, and suspense, often involving a "whodunit" element. JUNE 16TH-20TH (CLOSED THURSDAY, JUNE 19TH)

& AUGUST 11TH-15TH - CHECKMATE

One of the world's oldest games comes to World Academy! Campers will learn the basics of chess and its strategies from opening sequences to tactics to endgames. Campers will complete chess puzzles and learn about the history of the game by watching videos that have them apply their growing knowledge of the game to get the correct answers. Campers will also spend time playing one another in mini-tournaments throughout the camp. By week's end, they will be prepared to take on the world of chess! *Instructor: Chess Master, Dan Kilgour*

JUNE 23RD-27TH - WELCOME TO STRIXHAVEN! (DUNGEONS & DRAGONS)

Ever wonder what it is like to be a part of a school of wizardry and magic and knights and dragons? Through this camp, your student will get to experience the world of the popular roleplaying game Dungeons & Dragons through the Strixhaven adventure module set against the backdrop of a school for budding wizards, knights, and everyone in between. Students will learn valuable skills such as how to design characters, how to work as a team to achieve a common goal, and how to tell an effective story. *Instructor: Dan Kilgour (A D&D player for over 30 years!)*

JUNE 30TH-JULY 4TH (CLOSED FRIDAY, JULY 4TH)- CERAMICS WORKSHOP

Get ready for an incredible art camp experience as aspiring artists will dive into the fascinating world of ceramics. Artists will gain an arsenal of tools as they spend the week learning how to coil clay, pinch pots, and the intricacies of slab pots. Students will create multiple projects throughout the week using both air dry clay and polymer clay that they'll be able to paint and take home. Sculptures, pots, keychains, magnets and much more are within the grasp for young artists this week. *Instructor: Our 'Artist in Residence', Ms. Adrienne*

July 7th-11th - eSPORTS GALORE

In this realm, students will learn the basics of eSports, utilizing Rocket League and Mario Kart Deluxe 8 as tools. During these sessions, students will learn the basics of each game alongside one another employing school-provided resources. All week, students will compete against one another in each game to show their progress and growth. *Instructor: eSports Coordinator, Dan Kilgour*

July 14th-18th - PODCASTING FROM SOUP TO NUTS

In this realm, campers will learn to design and produce a podcast on a subject or idea of their choosing. They will learn how to develop a podcast topic, access interviewing techniques, record a show, audio edit, and create the final production of a simple podcast. *Instructor: Legoman Dan Hughes*

July 21st-25th - INTRODUCTION TO DRONES

During this scope and sequence, campers will learn how drones work, the rules of flying them, and how to safely pilot a drone. The program will pair them up in teams of two to solve a series of challenges while using proper techniques to fly a drone. The drones used in this realm are the same drones used in the World Championship Aerial Drone Competition. *Instructor: Legoman Dan Hughes*

July 28th-August 1st - FLOATING 3D CREATIONS

Here campers will use 3D design software to create various items on 3D printers. They will develop skills to allow them to improve their design ideas and make their creations more dynamic. The goal will be to have them design a 3D printed boat that will compete in our wild water racing challenge at the end of the week. *Instructor: Legoman Dan Hughes*

August 4th-8th - DESIGN & FUN WITH ROBOTICS

Robotics is a fun way to demonstrate creativity. Campers will work in teams to design robots to play games, as well as race and battle each other for glory and fame. Campers will practice build techniques, learn basic program skills, and use their design skills to shape unique and creative robots. At the end of the week, campers will have a chance to showcase their favorite designs. *Instructor: Legoman Dan Hughes*

August 18th-22nd - UNLEASH YOUR CREATIVITY THROUGH VAN GOGH AND MONET!

In this thrilling adventure, students will not only uncover the captivating world of renowned artists like Van Gogh and Monet but also embark on a journey to create their very own replica and mixed media art pieces and works of their own heavily inspired by these great artists. Get ready to dive into the vibrant strokes of Van Gogh and the enchanting landscapes of Monet as we unleash our inner artists!
